Snapping objects. When you move or draw an object, you can snap it to another object in a drawing. You can snap an object to a number of snap points in the target object. When the pointer is close to a snap point, the snap point is highlighted, indicating it as the pointer's snapping target. To snap an object to another object with greater precision, you first snap the pointer to a snap point in the object, and then snap the object to a snap point in the target object.

If you want to snap primary elements (nodes, cursor, bounding box, interactive markers, special nodes, text baselines, text glyphs...) to guidelines, just enable 'Snap to Guidelines'. If you want to snap certain snapping modes (Center, Quadrant, Tangent, Midpoint...) to guidelines, enable 'Snap to Guidelines' and 'Snap to Objects' (or 'Dynamic Guides') .

In some applications, guidelines are known as guides. There are three types of guidelines: horizontal, vertical, and slanted. By default, the application displays guidelines that you add to the drawing window, but you can hide them at any time.
