Under the London Help to Buy scheme, people buying a new-build home in Greater London can apply for an equity loan of up to 40% of the property 's value. This means you can put down a deposit of 5%, borrow up to 40% of the property price from the government and take out a mortgage on the rest, potentially unlocking better interest rates and improving your chances of getting accepted by a lender.

Where to buy in Zone 3: first-time buyer hotspots Havering and Bexley are the only other boroughs with average deposits under £60,000. Towards central London the figures rocket, with the biggest, an eye-watering £190,518, paid in Hammersmith and Fulham .

At ticket machines at Tube, London Overground, most TfL Rail and National Rail stations (7 Day or Monthly Travelcard) At Visitor Centres (All Visitor Centres sell 7 Day and Monthly Travelcards. Heathrow, King's Cross, Liverpool Street, Piccadilly Circus and Victoria Visitor Centres sell 3 month, 6 month and odd period Travelcards)

**Buying tickets and Oyster - Transport for London**

If your Travelcard is valid in Zones 3, 4, 5 or 6, you can use it on all trams. Tube, DLR, London Overground, TfL Rail and National Rail. You can use a Travelcard in the zones it's valid for. Make sure it covers all the zones you travel through. If not, you need to add pay as you go credit to your Oyster card or buy an extension ticket ...

**Earn £30,000 - do I have any chance of buying a London**

You can add money to an Oyster card or use contactless (card or device) straight away. You only pay for the journeys you make and it's cheaper than buying a paper single or return ticket (train companies may offer special deals on some journeys).. In Zones 1-9, your fare is capped so you can travel as much as you like in one day or week (Monday to Sunday), without paying more.

The centre of London, including most major attractions, is in Zones 1-2. Most suburban areas of London, including Wembley Stadium and Wimbledon Tennis Club, are within Zones 1-4. Almost the whole of London, including both Heathrow and London City airports, are in Zones 1-6.
